Throughout all of its seventeen seasons, the show has been hosted by news correspondent John Quiñones.

Usher promoted Here I Stand by performing on several television shows including Total Request Live, 106 & Park and Good Morning America. Among other concert appearances, he embarked on a One Night Stand: Ladies Only Tour, performing fifteen...
