An architect's decisions affect public safety, and thus the architect must undergo specialised training consisting of advanced education and a practicum (or internship) for practical experience to earn a license to practice architecture. Prior to 2024, the president of the United States appointed the architect upon confirmation vote by the United States Senate, and was accountable to the president.

Because of the extensive experience required for this, the systems architect is typically a very senior technologist with substantial, but general, knowledge of hardware...
