Additionally, the ONS's estimates on GVA adapt to regional disparities in commuting regions by allocating the GVA to the area in which an employee commuted from. They also use five-period moving averages to smooth data.

The "PDQ" identifies the platform as being a production and oil drilling facility with crew quarters.
