Based on the 1987 Hudson Talbott children's book of the same name, it tells the story of three dinosaurs and one pterosaur who travel to the present day and become intelligent by eating a "Brain Grain" cereal invented by scientist Captain Neweyes. The film was produced by Steven Spielberg's Amblimation studio and features the voices of John Goodman, Felicity Kendal, Charles Fleischer, Walter Cronkite, Jay Leno, Julia Child, Kenneth Mars, Yeardley Smith, and Martin Short.

Go motion is a variation of stop motion animation which incorporates motion blur into each frame involving motion. It was co-developed by Industrial Light & Magic and Phil Tippett. Stop motion animation can create a distinctive and disorienting staccato effect because the animated object is perfectly sharp in every frame, since each frame is shot with the object perfectly still. Real moving objects in similar scenes have motion blur because they move while the camera's shutter is open. Filmmakers use a variety of techniques to simulate motion blur, such as moving the model slightly during the exposure of each film frame, or placing a glass plate smeared with petroleum jelly in front of the camera lens to blur the moving areas.

Barney is a children's educational musical adventure media franchise that originated with the 1988 direct-to-video series *Barney & the Backyard Gang* by Sheryl Stamps-Leach and Kathy O'Rourke-Parker. Barney consists of three series—*Barney & the Backyard Gang* (1988–1991), which consists of only eight episodes, *Barney & Friends* (1992–2010), a television series that ran on PBS Kids, and *Barney's World* (2024), a fully animated series set to air on Cartoon Network's Cartoonito, and which is currently streaming on Max—and is currently distributed by 9 Story Media Group, under license from Mattel Television.

Elizabeth Bonnin (born 16 September 1976) is a French-Irish science, wildlife and natural history presenter, who has worked on television in both Ireland and the United Kingdom. She presented morning show *RI:SE* and music show *Top of the Pops* in the early 2000s.

She is best known for presenting wildlife and science programmes including *Galapagos*, *How the Earth Works*, *Animals in Love*, *Stargazing Live*, *Blue Planet Live*, *Cats v Dogs: Which is Best?* and *Should We Close Our Zoos?*. She co-presented the BBC factual series *Bang Goes the Theory* from 2009 until 2014 and since 2013, has co-presented *Countrywise* for ITV. In 2019, she presented *Meat: A Threat to our Planet?* on BBC One. She is regarded as one of the most prominent natural world presenters in Britain.

Hank the Cowdog is a long-running American series of children's books written by John R. Erickson and illustrated originally by Gerald L. Holmes, and later by Nikki Earley. The books follow Hank, a dog who views himself as the "Head of Ranch Security". Hank suffers a superiority complex, and thinks he is smarter than everybody else; his intelligence is limited to that of the average dog. In each book Hank and other characters must deal with several events, issues and mysteries that occur at their Texas Panhandle home in Ochiltree County. The name of the ranch is never mentioned in any of the stories. The series began in 1982, with a couple of short stories about Hank and his friends; since then, 83 printed books and seven audio-only books have been published. Hank the Cowdog was previously...

One Million B.C. is a 1940 American fantasy film produced by Hal Roach Studios and released by United Artists. It is also known by the titles Cave Man, Man and His Mate, and Tumak.

The film stars Victor Mature as protagonist Tumak, a young caveman who strives to unite the uncivilized Rock Tribe and the peaceful Shell Tribe, Carole Landis as Loana, daughter of the Shell Tribe chief and Tumak's love interest, and Lon Chaney Jr. as Tumak's stern father and leader of the Rock Tribe. Chaney's billing differs from that of his home studio Universal Pictures in that Hal Roach elected to retain the "Jr." instead of billing him under his father's name, possibly because Roach was co-directing the film with his own son Hal Roach Jr.

The film was a popular success and was nominated for two Academy Awards...
