Playboi Carti

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Jordan Terrell Carter (born September 13, 1995, or 1996), known professionally as Playboi Carti, is an American rapper. Known for his eccentric vocal style and fashion, he is considered an influential figure in modern hip-hop and a pioneer of the rage microgenre.

Born and raised in Atlanta, Carter began uploading his music online in 2011 and became popular in the SoundCloud rap community. He signed with the local underground record label Awful Records in 2014, and signed with the ASAP Mob's record label AWGE, a joint venture with Interscope Records, in 2016. Carter gained mainstream attention following the release of his eponymous debut mixtape (2017), which peaked at number 12 on the U.S. Billboard 200 and spawned the Billboard Hot 100-charting singles "Magnolia" and "Wokeuplikethis" (featuring...
